## **PROJECT AT A GLANCE**

The Government of Rajasthan through Public Works Department (PWD) awarded the work for development and upgardation of 2-lane road from KM 0/0 to KM 212/0 from Jaipur to Bhilwara via, Renwal, Phagi, Malpura, Kekri, Sahpura and Mandal including widening of existing structures, providing wayside amenities, Truck lay bye (3 nos), Bus bays (7 nos), installation of 4 nos Toll Plaza for fee collection and operation and maintenance of the project till concession period of 22 years. This upgraded State Highway from Jaipur to Bhilwara have improved the overall economic development of the nearby towns and villages. This State Highway will also attract industrial growth of important towns of Phagi, Malpura, Kekri and Shahpura. It will also reduce the travel time from Jaipur to Bhilwara by almost 1 hour.
