SPML Infra will play a key role in the development of sustainable water infrastructure to realise the vision of "Nal Se Jal". This ambitious scheme announced by the Finance Minister during her maiden budget presentation aims to provide piped water connection to every household in India by 2024. Given the massive number of connecting about 140 million remaining rural and urban households in five years' time will be a challenging task.

The company has received four new orders for water supply and irrigation projects with combined cost of more than Rs 883 crore from Gujarat, Manipur and Punjab. The first and the largest single order received by SPML Infra is worth Rs 723.87 crore for phase three of Saurashtra-Narmada Avtaran Irrigation (SAUNI Yojana), an ambitious project initiated by the Gujarat state government.

It has also received new project orders worth Rs 177.4 crore from Jharkhand Urja Sancharan Nigam. The orders have been received for 132/33 kV substation projects to be completed in 24 months period. These projects are funded by the World Bank under 'Jharkhand Power System Improvement Project' scheme.

Sethi said the company "is well positioned to take advantage of new business opportunities in water infrastructure development and power transmission and distribution sector, both present and emerging"

## SPML Infra Ltd. received New Project Orders worth Rs. 218 Crore

SPML Infra Limited has received new project orders worth Rs. 218.18 Crores. The two orders for wastewater treatment projects in Uttar Pradesh and Haryana has been received from the esteemed clients, Uttar Pradesh Jal Nigam, Varanasi and Haryana State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd., Bahadurgarh.

- > Rs. 183.68 Crore Order is for the planning, designing, engineering, procurement, construction, testing and commissioning of 30 MLD Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) and interception and diversion of drain in Jaunpur, Uttar Pradesh for pollution abatement of River Ganga under the National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG). The project has been received with JV partner, Pulkit Projects.
- > Rs. 34.50 Crore Order is for the planning, designing, engineering, procurement, construction, testing and commissioning of 10 MLD Common Effluent Treatment Plant (CETP) and 30 MLD Main Pumping Station based on tertiary treatment for the industrial estate of Bahadurgarh, Haryana.

## SPML Infra's Subsidiary Company Bhilwara Jaipur Toll Road Pvt. Ltd. Wins Rs. 191 Crore Interim Relief under Arbitration Proceedings

M/s. Bhilwara Jaipur Toll Road Pvt. Ltd., a subsidiary company with 51% stake of SPML Infra Limited got Rs.191 Crore Interim Relief under Arbitration proceedings against State of Rajasthan. The 212 kilometer Bhilwara-Jaipur Toll Road was developed by the subsidiary company but with effect from 1st April 2018, Govt. of Rajasthan had exempted private vehicles to pay toll in 0-212 km toll road (state highway) from Jaipur to Bhilwara. Due to this decision, the daily toll collection was badly affected and the company, M/s. Bhilwara Jaipur Toll Road Pvt. Ltd. has terminated the concession agreement on the basis of material default by State Govt. An arbitrator was appointed by the Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan to resolve the matter.

M/s. Bhilwara Jaipur Toll Road Pvt. Ltd. had sought an interim relief under Section 17 of Arbitration Act to give award in the way that bank debt on state highway is taken over or settled and the toll road is taken back by the State Govt. for onward operation and maintenance. The arbitrator after hearings under section 17 of Arbitration Act has issued an interim order of award on 30th October, 2019 directing the State Govt. to deposit Rs.191 Crore in bank escrow account and take possession of the toll road. The regular arbitration proceedings of this project under Section 34 of the Arbitration Act are going on and our claim of termination payment of Rs.578 Crore is in the process of hearing.





**12.5 MLD Common Effluent Treatment Plant, Bahadurgarh, Haryana**

SPML Infra has completed an important industrial wastewater treatment project in Haryana. The construction work of 12.5 MLD Common Effluent Treatment Plant (CETP) based on tertiary treatment method is completed. The CETP has been constructed to provide used water treatment facility to commercial and industrial units based in the Industrial Estate of Bahadurgarh.



**Extension of 400/220 kV Durgapur Sub-station**

SPML Infra has completed an important power transmission & distribution project in Durgapur, West Bengal under the Eastern Region Strengthening Scheme. Scope of the project includes engineering, supply, erection, testing & commissioning of 400/220 KV AIS substation, 220 KV bays, 315-500 MVA autotransformer, civil, electrical & mechanical works. The Durgapur sub-station project will help the client in providing better quality electricity supply to the designated areas of Durgapur and suburbs. Under the Eastern Region Strengthening Scheme, SPML Infra is also executing similar projects in 6 sites at Malda, Jeypore, Rourkela, Angul, and two units of 400 kV Substation in Maithon in West Bengal, Jharkhand and Odisha states.



## INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT - RS.102 LAC CRORE TO BE SPENT IN 5 YEARS

Road To \$5 Trillion Economy In recent years, India has emerged as the most attractive destinations for doing business and making investments. The fastest growing major economy in 2018 and 2019; India is the 5th largest economy in the world by nominal GDP and 3rd largest economy globally in terms of Purchase-Power-Parity (PPP). With large share in world FDI inflows and trade growth, demand of strong Infrastructure is essential.

Recently, the Finance Minister Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman has released a report of the Task Force on National Infrastructure Pipeline for 2019-2025. To achieve the GDP of \$5 trillion by 2024-25, India needs to spend about \$1.4 trillion (Rs. 100 lakh crore) over these years on infrastructure. To achieve this objective, a Task Force was constituted to draw up the National Infrastructure Pipeline (NIP) for each of the years from FY 2019-20 to FY 2024-25. NIP will enable a forward outlook on infrastructure projects which will create jobs, improve ease of living, and

provide equitable access to infrastructure for all, thereby making growth more inclusive. NIP includes both economic and social infrastructure projects.

Under the National Infrastructure Pipeline, total project capital expenditure in infrastructure sectors in India during the fiscals 2020 to 2025 is projected to be over Rs 102 lakh crore.

As reported, Out of the total expected capital expenditure of Rs. 102 lakh crore, projects worth Rs 42.7 lakh crore (42%) are under implementation, projects worth Rs 32.7 lakh crore (32%) are in conceptualization stage and rest are under development. It is expected that projects of certain states, which are yet to communicate their pipelines, would be added to the pipeline in due course.

The Task Force in its detailed report has given recommendations on changes required to several key sectorial policies and other reform initiatives to be taken up by Central and State Governments. A monitoring mechanism has also been suggested to ensure timely implementation.



During the fiscals 2020 to 2025, sectors such as Energy (24%), Roads (19%), Urban (16%), and Railways (13%) amount to around 70% of the projected capital expenditure in infrastructure in India. The detailed sector wise break of the pipeline is as follows:
