



SPML Wins India Water Line Supply Contracts

SPML Infra Ltd. (SPML), an Indian builder, won 4.2 billion rupees (\$78 million) of contracts for water infrastructure work in the western state of Rajasthan. The shares climbed to a three-month high.

The Kolkata company will commission, maintain and operate the water supply projects being developed in the cities of Pokharan, Balotra and Siwana for 10 years, according to a statement filed to the stock exchange today.

SPML Infra's stock surged as much as 18 percent to the highest since Aug. 17 in Mumbai trading.
