Elecon bags Rs. 100 cr order

Gujarat based Elecon Engineering Company Limited has been awarded letter of intent (LoI) from Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd. (BHEL) Industrial System Group for supply of Rs. 104.41 crore machine package. The order comprises stacker cum reclaimer with rails, rail accessories, clamps, fixtures, hoists belt weigher, all electrical hydraulic drives and accessories (includes design, engineering, manufacturing, inspection, supply, transportation, & supply of conveyor package system). ■

Bagging of Road Contract worth Rs. 394.3 Crores

L&FS Engineering and Construction Company Ltd. has been awarded a Turnkey EPC contract by DLF Limited for a value of Rs. 394.3 crore for construction of High Speed HUDA Sector Road starting from NH-8 to Sector 55/56 at Gurgaon. The Project is to be completed in 18 months from the date of commencement of work with a maintenance period of 5 years. ■

Satec Envir Engineering bags a prestigious coal power plant project in Jharkhand

Satec Envir Engineering has bagged an order valued over 30 cr to supply fabricated material for conveyor gallery and trestles at 2X600 MW in Tori power project Jharkhand.

Satec will be providing 5000 tons of steel structure and the scope of work includes bolted connection design, supply of structure material, cleaning and painting and non destructive testing of the fabricated structure. This project is likely to be completed by March 2013. Ministry of power India has awarded this project status of Mega power project in Jharkhand. ■

Bids Successfully

L&T Infrastructure Development Projects Limited (L&T IDPL) emerged as the successful project bidder to develop two contiguous road projects of length 484 km 4 lane road at a cost of approximately ₹4800 Crore. Separate Special Purpose Vehicles (SPVs), subsidiaries of L&T IDPL signed Concession Agreements with the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI). Both the projects have concession period of 20 years, including a construction period of 30 months.

The two road sections are part of NH 6 connecting Surat to Kolkata, and are a prominent East-West connector. The projects are the longest stretches to be offered in Maharashtra on Build-Operate-Transfer (BOT) basis. NH6 is also called the Great Eastern Road and passes through mineral rich states like Orissa and Chattisgarh and industrial states like Maharashtra and Gujarat. ■
