## REPOWER BAGS CONTRACT FROM FRENCH FIRM

Wind turbine maker Suzlon said its subsidiary REpower has bagged an order for supplying turbines to four wind farms in France. "REpower Systems SE signed a contract with Valorem for 24 wind turbines of 2 megawatt power capacity to be supplied to four windfarms in French Picardie, Pays de la Loire and Burgundy regions," said Suzlon. REpower will also provide the full maintenance of the windfarms for 10 year. ■
