

## Pratibha Industries bags order in Rajasthan

Value: Rs 230 crore



**P**ratibha Industries has bagged a Rs 230-crore order from Public Health Engineering Department of Jaipur for water supply project. Reports say that the contract is for work of cluster scheme of 151 villages of Banera and Hurda Tehsils along with augmentation of UWSS (Urban Water Supply Scheme) of Gulabpura town from Danta Pyara Headworks under Chambal-Bhilwara water supply projects. This work also includes operation and maintenance for 10 years, according to sources.

The contract is scheduled to be completed in 36 months from the date of commencement.

## SPML Infra secures various orders

Value: Rs 1,802.10 crore

**S**PML Infra Ltd has won new orders from South Bihar Power Distribution Company Ltd (SBPDCL), Bihar and Public Health Engineering Department (PHED) of Rajasthan.

The two orders received from SBPDCL worth Rs 1,000 crore are for the rural electrification projects in Patna and Gaya districts under Rajiv Gandhi Gramen Vidhyutikaran Yojana. ## BHEL bags order from NTPC

**B**HEL's electronics division has bagged an order from NTPC to set up a 15 MW solar power plant in Uttar Pradesh. The

EPC order is for design, manufacture, testing, erection and commissioning of the 15 MW grid-interactive solar power plant at Singrauli in Uttar Pradesh, as per reports. Reports add that BHEL will execute the project covering all works from concept to commissioning and will operate and maintain the project for one year. The solar plant is planned near the 2,000 MW thermal power plant of NTPC at Singrauli. On completion, it is expected to supply over 23 million units of solar power every year to the Uttar Pradesh State grid.

## Siemens to construct 38 new substations in Bangladesh

Value: Rs 144 crore
