

SPML Infra bags Rs 600 crore projects in Delhi, Rajasthan

New Delhi : Delhi-based leading water infrastructure company SPML Infra has said it has bagged new orders worth nearly Rs 600 crore from Delhi Jal Board (DJB) and PHED, Rajasthan.

The company said it secured two order worth Rs 178 crore order from DJB for supply, installation and maintenance of water meters in Delhi. The first order is of Rs 151 crore for supply, installation and seven years maintenance of AMR/non-AMR water meters in Delhi.

The second order of Rs 27 crore is for supply, installation and four year maintenance of bulk water meters with remote reading device capable of transmitting data of various sizes.

A company statement said the combined orders received from PHED, Jaipur and Ajmer were to the tune of Rs 418 crore for water supply schemes to more than 337 villages and dhanies in Nagaur, Tonk and Sikar districts.

More than a million people in these villages will benefit from drinking water facility once these projects are completed. SPML will also be responsible for the operations & maintenance of these water infrastructures for a decade after the commissioning.

The order from PHED Jaipur also requires building of a 200 million litre per day (MLD) water treatment plant with latest technology. The company said the Rs 122 crore order from PHED, Jaipur is for extension of water treatment plant from existing 400 MLD to 600 MLD at Surajpura in Tonk district.

Also, the order from PHED, Jaipur includes Rs 118 crore order for water supply scheme to 191 villages and dhanies in Tonk district with operation & maintenance for nine years, Rs 97 crore order from PHED, Jaipur for water supply scheme to 72 villages and dhanies in Nagaur district with operation & maintenance for 10 years. Also, there is a Rs 81 crore order from PHED, Ajmer for cluster water supply to 74 villages of Sikar district.

SPML Infra Executive Director **Rishabh Sethi** said, "SPML has been promoting sustainable water management over the years and has established itself as a preferred partner for water infrastructure development in India. Water management is our core competency and we intend to grow at a rapid pace in this segment. We are already developing infrastructure for drinking water supply in parts of Delhi and the new orders from Delhi Jal Board is a boost to our effort in improving the water supply to the residents of Delhi and providing accurate meter readings to Delhi Jal Board".

"We are also motivated to receive the new orders from PHED, Rajasthan. The projects cover the entire gamut of drinking water system – treatment, pipeline, pumping stations, metering etc. We are continuing to strive towards becoming a one – stop solution provider for all water supply needs for cities.
