

SPML Infrastructure obtains fresh orders worth Rs 772 cr

SPML Infrastructure has bagged fresh orders worth Rs 772 crore from the state governments of Rajasthan and Karnataka. "SPML has obtained new orders worth Rs 772.20 crore from Public Health Engineering Department (PHED) of Rajasthan and Bangalore Water Supply & Sewerage Board (BWSSB) Karnataka," a company statement to the stock exchange said.

The two orders received from PHED, Jodhpur and Bharatpur are for development of rural water supply schemes which will benefit more than 365 villages. The order from PHED, Jodhpur is for the execution of work related to transmission mains for water supply scheme.

The BWSSB order is first of its kind project for reduction of non-revenue water (NRW) for Bangalore city. SPML will be executing this project with its joint venture partner. The scope of work for Rs 164.60 crore include improvements of water distribution systems, reduction in UFW and leakage control from Bangalore Water Supply & Sewerage board is spread into two stages. SPML Infra, infrastructure development firm has implemented over 400 projects in water supply and management, wastewater treatment and re-use, sewer-line rehabilitation and power development, transmission and distribution in India.
