



SPML Infra Obtains New Orders worth Rs. 772.20 Crores

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SPML Infra has received two new orders worth Rs. 772.20 Crores from the Rajasthan Public Health Engineering Department (PHED) and Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board (BWSSB), Karnataka.

The first order, valued at Rs. 372 cr was awarded by PHED, Jodhpur. SPML Infra will execute transmission mains for water supply scheme for 256 villages and the town of Bhinmal in the Jalore district.

The order includes construction of a raw water reservoir, water treatment plant, raw and clear water transmission mains, a 33/6.6kV switchyard, and civil, mechanical, electrical and instrumentation works. The construction period is 36 months with operation and maintenance for 10 years post commissioning.

The second contract, awarded by PHED, Bharatpur, is worth Rs. 234 cr. The contract is a rural water supply scheme for 109 villages and other habitants in the Karouli district with operation and maintenance for 10 years.

BWSSB, Bangalore awarded the third contract valued at Rs. 164 cr. SPML Infra will provide water distribution system improvements and leakage control and reduce unaccounted-for water with five years of operation and maintenance.
