



## SPML Infra Secures Orders For Rs.772.20 Cr.

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SPML Infra Ltd. (SPML) has obtained two orders worth Rs.772.20 crore from the Public Health Engineering Department (PHED) of Rajasthan and Bangalore Water Supply & Sewerage Board (BWSSB), Karnataka.

The order from PHED, Jodhpur and Bharatpur, was Rs.607.60 crore for rural water supply schemes, and the BWSSB order, valued Rs 164.60 crore, was for reducing non-revenue water (NRW) for Bangalore city.

The BWSSB order is first of its kind project for reduction on non-revenue water for Bangalore city.

SPML will be executing this project with its joint venture partner SUEZ Environment with the implementation of modern [technology](#) for leak detection and installing DMA meters along with other initiatives.

With these new orders, SPML has already received Rs.3,680 crore orders within this current fiscal year and the company's order book position has touched Rs.7,000 crore mark, which will give revenue visibility to the company for the next three years. The company hopes to add more project in the remaining six months of this fiscal.
