

SPML Infra Secures Rs.1,802.10 Cr. Orders

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Infrastructure development company SPML Infra Ltd. has won new orders worth Rs.1,802.10 crore from South Bihar Power Distribution Co. Ltd. (SBPDCL), Bihar, and Public Health Engineering Department (PHED) of Rajasthan.

The two orders received from SBPDCL for Rs.1,000 crore were for the rural electrification projects in Patna and Gaya districts under Rajiv Gandhi Grameen Vidhyutikaran Yojana.

Rural work in Patna district involves construction, erection, testing and commissioning of new 33 and 11kV substations, augmentation of 33 and 11kV existing substations, 7,246 km long 33kV and 11kV new transmission lines, reconductoring of 56,164 km of 33kV lines, 5,309 km of LT lines, and providing BPL service connections to almost 4 lakh consumers.

Rural electrification work in Gaya district includes construction, erection, testing and commissioning of new 33 and 11kV substations, augmentation of 33 and 11kV existing substations, 6,183 km long 33kV and 11kV new transmission lines, reconductoring of 57,733 km of 33kV lines, 6,508 km of LT lines, and providing BPL service connections to almost 3 lakh consumers.

The three orders received from PHED, Kota, Ajmer and Bharatpur, aggregating to Rs.802.10 crore were for water supply schemes benefiting more than 445 villages and their dhanies in Ajmer, Bharatpur and Jhalawar districts. SPML will also be responsible for the operations and maintenance of these water infrastructure projects for a decade after the commissioning.

The scope of work for Rs.308.59 crore Gagreen Water Supply Project in district Jhalawar involves construction and commissioning of intake pumping stations, raw water mains, water treatment plant, clear water reservoir, elevated service reservoirs, cluster distribution and village distribution system with associated civil, electrical and mechanical works with PLC & SCADA on single responsibility turnkey basis to be completed in 36 months with ten years of operation and maintenance.

The Rs.247.81 crore order from PHED, Ajmer, was for regional water supply scheme for 199 villages and their habitants of Jawaja Panchayat Samiti in Beawar tehsil of Ajmer district. This project was on design-build-operate basis to be completed in 36 months with nine year of operation and maintenance post commissioning.

The Rs.245.70 crore project has come from PHED, Bharatpur, for development of regional water supply infrastructure for 246 villages and their NRVs and dhanies of Kaman & Pahari tehsils of district Bharatpur under Chlorination disinfection by-products water supply scheme. The time line of this single responsibility turnkey basis project is 30 months and SPML will be responsible for its operation and maintenance for ten years after the commissioning.

Executive Director Rishabh Sethi said, "Within this fiscal year 2014, we have received new orders worth Rs.2,886 crore till date and hope to add more in the coming months. We are very happy that with these orders, SPML's order book position has crossed Rs.6,000 crore mark that gives us the revenue visibility for next three years.

At the BSE, SPML Infra closed Tuesday's trading at Rs.29.30, up 4.64 percent from the previous close.
