



SPML Infra surges on bagging new orders worth Rs 267 crore from KUIDFC

SPML Infra has won new orders worth Rs 267 crore from Karnataka Urban Infrastructure Development and Finance Corporation (KUIDFC) for 24X7 Water Supply System for three cities, Sindhanur, Gadag-Betageri and Haveri with a combined population of 3.7 lakh. These projects are part of Asian Development Bank (ADB) funded projects to improve urban services in 14 towns in north Karnataka. The project would help improve the quality of life in underdeveloped areas of the State with uninterrupted clean drinking water supply.

The company has received these performance-based management contracts to design and construct the infrastructure of the distribution networks, provide metered connections and operate and maintain the facilities for 5 years. The three orders received are Gadag-Betageri - Rs 107.86 crore; Sindhanur - Rs 99.01 crore; Haveri - Rs 59.92 crore. The scope of work for Gadag-Betageri involves 302.16 kms of HDPE/DI/PVC/MS 100, PN 6 pipeline, Construction of Over Head Tank of 4 Million Litres capacity and 41618 Nos. of House Service Connections.

Besides, Sindhanur scope of work includes 178.70 kms HDPE/DI/PVC/MS 100, PN 6 pipeline, three split case centrifugal pump clear water pumping station of capacity 57.00 Lps with 40 mts head at existing water treatment plant and 11938 Nos. of House Service Connections. The Haveri scope of work involves 158 kms HDPE/DI/PVC/MS 100, PN 6 pipeline, Construction of 1.5 Million Litres capacity Over Head Tank and 16325 Nos. of House Service Connections with 5 years of Operations & maintenance.
