

## SPML Infra hits the roof

**SPML Infra hit an upper circuit limit** of 10 per cent at Rs 34.80 on the BSE after the company said it received new multiple orders worth Rs 721 crore.

According to a release issued by the company to the BSE, The Company won its first order from Bhavnagar Irrigation Project Division in Gujarat, worth Rs 594 crore, is for Water Supply Infrastructure development.

The second order from South Bihar Power Distribution Company, worth Rs 127 crore, is for strengthening, improvement and augmentation of electricity distribution system in 11 towns in Bihar, the company said in a statement.
