

SPML Infra announced that it secured orders worth INR 12.32 billion

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The company has secured two orders from Uttar Pradesh Jal Nigam, Agra; and one from Sardar Sarovar Narmada Nigam, Gandhinagar.

The two orders, 5B and 5C, received from UP Jal Nigam, are worth Rs 1,002.17 crore. They are to augment the drinking water supply for Agra city with laying of 128 km of water pipeline.

SPML's scope of work for 5B contract includes supply and construction of two parallel 2,100 mm diameter mild steel conveyance main of 96 km (48 km each side of twin pipeline), which will be further extended to Mathura Water Treatment Plant under a different contract.

The scope of work under 5C contract includes supply and construction of 2,800 mm diameter mild steel conveyance main of 32 km. This project will be executed with aid from Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA). SPML will be implementing this project in a joint venture with Megha Engineering Infrastructure.

The Sardar Sarovar Narmada Nigam order is for construction of three hydro power plants. SPML Infra will execute the project in a joint venture with Om Metals Infracore.
