

## SPML Infra jumps 10% on new orders

SPML Infra, the infrastructure development company, jumped on Monday two new orders aggregating to Rs.721 crore from Bhavnagar Irrigation Projects Division, Gujarat and from South Bihar Power Distribution Co. Ltd., Patna.

Bhavnagar Irrigation Project Division has awarded a contract for Rs.594 crore for water supply to Bhavnagar. This project is part of Saurashtra-Narmada Avtaran Irrigation Yojana (Sauni Yojana) that has been initiated by the Govt of Gujarat to deliver excess over flowing flood water of Narmada River to allocated Saurashtra region.

The scope of this project includes laying of 40.75 km MS pipeline apart from 13,475 m<sup>3</sup>/hr pumping station at Chinage 30.9 km. SPML will also be responsible for 66kV outdoor type substations with all allied works and operations and maintenance for ten years after the commissioning.

The company has bagged another order for Rs.127 crore from Bihar Power Distribution Company for survey, network design, installation, erection, testing, commissioning including performance test of all the equipment supplied under the supply contract for strengthening the electricity distribution system in 11 towns (Sultanganj, Banka, Naughachiya, Munger, Sheikhpura, Barbigaha, Jamalpur, Lakhisarai, Jhajha, Barhiya and Jamui) under Bhagalpur Electricity Supply Area in Bihar on turnkey basis.
