■ The joint venture of Delhi-based SPML Infra Limited and Om Metal Infracore Limited has bagged a smart infrastructure development project worth Rs 3.25 billion for the proposed smart city, Vikram Udyogpuri in Ujjain, Madhya Pradesh. The project is being implemented under the development plan of Pithampur-Dhar-Mhow Investment Region which is one of the 24 regions of Delhi Mumbai Industrial Corridor. Under the project, SPML Infra will be responsible for developing smart infrastructure facilities for 24x7 water supply comprising WTPs and pumping station, water supply conveyance system from Shipra river to the site, complete sewerage network with sewage treatment and effluent treatment plants, storm water drainage system and solid waste management system, among others. The project will be implemented on a design-build-operate basis. It is scheduled to be completed within a period of three years with operation and maintenance for five years post commissioning.
