SPML Infra gains 8%, JV company wins orders worth Rs 1275cr

The company's joint venture with Tata Projects have received three major new orders for design and construction of Sewerage System with provision of treated wastewater reuse from RUDSICO for 11 cities in Rajasthan for a total value of Rs 1275 crore.

"These projects are envisaged as decentralized sewage treatment projects similar to the ones being proposed under Namami Gange program. The treated wastewater reuse can provide alternative source of water, reduce pollution to ground water sources thus improving health and economic productivity," as per company's press release. It includes order of Rs 480 crore for the development of sewer system in Bharatpur, Gangapur, Hinduan and Churu cities and order is of Rs 417 crore for the same in Udaipur, Nagaur, Sujangarh and Baran. The third order is for the development of sewer system in Chittorgarh, Beawar and Bundi cities worth of Rs 378 crore. Rishabh Sethi, Executive Director of SPML Infra said, "SPML is indeed proud to be part of this improvement plan to create wastewater treatment and reuse infrastructure which are vital to make fresh water available for drinking purposes."
