Through incessant dialogue and interacting within the government, we finally made them understand the benefits of outsourcing project execution in water industry to the private sector and that was the practical beginning to the now widely prevalent **Engineering Procurement** and Construction (EPC) business model.

IMPACTING LIVES

From the beginning of my career, I was driven by the ideas to create the impossible and was attracted to make positive impact for the large populace. The idea of water infrastructure development and management business was the result of an idea only that transformed lives of millions of people in the country. Today, we are providing drinking water and electricity to thousands of households and mainly in the rural India. One of our important water supply projects in Rajasthan, in absolutely desert of Jaisalmer district is providing drinking water to almost 600 villages and 4 towns where the women folks used to walk 5-10 kilometres everyday to fetch not very clean water for drinking and daily chores. We got the opportunity to work for them and we build large water treatment plants, pumping stations and about 500 kilometres of water supply pipeline to take clean drinking water to their doorsteps. Similarly our other water supply projects in different states has been instrumental in providing drinking water to thousands of villages and towns thus making people's lives comfortable.
