

## HCC bags Limbdi Branch Canal project

Value: Rs 298.63 crore

**H**industan Construction Company Ltd is awarded the Limbdi Branch Canal contract by Sardar Sarovar Narmada Nigam Ltd. The scope of work includes constructing canal earthwork, lining, structures and service roads of distributaries and minors of Limbdi Branch Canal including maintenance and operation for five years. The project will be completed in 18 months.

The Limbdi Branch Canal work will benefit 189 villages in eleven talukas of Ahmedabad, Bhavnagar and Surendranagar in Gujarat. It would extend irrigational benefits to 2.71 lakh acres of land in these three districts.

HCC has constructed seven irrigation dams, 18 barrages, 35 water treatment plants, 70 sewage treatment plants, India's first and largest private sector water supply project in Thirupur, Tamil Nadu, and has constructed more than 25 km of tunneling in a congested urban environment to a depth of 80 m in Mumbai.



## Unity Infra bags BOT project in Rajasthan

Value: Rs 198 crore

**T**he Public Works Department, Jaipur, has awarded a project for two-laning of section from Chomu to Mahal via Renwal, Jobner (SH-8B, SH-19, SH-2C, SHG-8A & ODR-02) to Unity Infraprojects Ltd on Design, Build, Finance, Operate & Transfer (DBFOT) basis. The concession period of the said project is 25 years and the completion period is 18 months. With the inclusion of this contract, the order book of the company now stands at Rs 3,860 crore.

## IVRCL bags multiple orders

Value: Rs 893.66 crore

**T**he water, buildings, power and transportation divisions of IVRCL Ltd have bagged orders worth Rs 893.66 crore, including work for Sardar Sarovar Narmada Nigam Ltd, Tamil Nadu Water Supply & Drainage Board and Haldia Energy Ltd.

The buildings division has secured order worth Rs 517.46 crore for construction of a hospital from Commissionerate of Health, Project Implementation Unit, Gandhinagar, and for lift pump works at Farakka Super Thermal Power Station from NTPC Ltd. The water division has bagged orders worth Rs 294.74 crore, which involves work for Sardar Sarovar Narmada Nigam Ltd, proposed MRF Ltd's plant in Tamil Nadu and Tabreed District Cooling Scheme of Dubai Metro Green Line. The power division has secured contract worth Rs 44.18 crore.

## SPML wins two orders

Value: Rs 262 crore



**S**PML Infra Ltd has won orders for water treatment plant and solid waste management. The first order worth Rs 137 crore from Goa Water Supply and Sewerage Board under the aegis of Public Works Department, Govt of Goa, is slated for the expansion of 100 MLD Water Treatment Plant at Salaulim, Goa. The Goa water treatment project will be executed through a joint venture between SPML Infra Ltd and SMC Infrastructures Pvt Ltd. SPML has also been awarded the integrated solid waste management project for Dehradun on public-private partnership (PPP) basis. The project, to be implemented in partnership with Dehradun Municipal Corporation, involves design, construction, operations and management of all aspects of municipal solid waste for a period of 14 years with cumulative projected revenue of Rs 125 crore. The project has the capacity of handling 300 tonnes of municipal solid waste per day at present, that will grow to 600 tonnes by the end of the concession period of 14 years.
