

SPML bags 616.72 crore order

Mumbai, Nov 22: SPML Infra limited, a leading infrastructure development company, today said it has received four new orders from the state governments of Gujarat and Rajasthan.

It has received two orders, worth Rs 513.28 crore, from Gujarat Water Infrastructure Ltd.(GWIL), a Government of Gujarat Undertaking, Gandhinagar, for providing, supplying, lowering, and commissioning of bulk water transmission main 2300 mm dia (FID), 14mm thick M.S.Pipe line From Dhanki to Navada near Ahmedabad-Rajkot Highway (NH8A) and From Dhanki to Dudhraj including civil and electro mechanical work with five year O and M, the company informed in a filing with BSE LTD.

It has received Third order for Rs 79.02 crore from Public health Engineering department Jaipur, Rajasthan, for work of RWSS of 153 villages and the dhanies from Maipura, Mor and Pachewar head work on TM-1 under bisalpur dudu water supply project on single responsibility lump sum basis and O and M for 10 years .

The fourth order is from Rajasthan Rajya Vidut Prasran Nigam Limited for supply and service contract towards construction of 400KV D/C twin ACSR Moose line from proposed 400kv substation, Chittograh to 400kv substation, Bhilwara, amounting to Rs 24.42 crore.
