

SPML Infra bags orders worth Rs 218 cr

SPML Infra, an infrastructure development company, has bagged project orders worth Rs 218.18 crore. The two orders are for waste water treatment projects in Uttar Pradesh and Haryana from Uttar Pradesh Jal Nigam, Varanasi and th Haryana State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation, Bahadurgarh.

The company has secured an order worth Rs 183.68 crore for planning, designing, engineering, procurement, construction, testing and commissioning of 30 MLD sewage treatment plant (STP) and interception and diversion of drain in Jaunpur, Uttar Pradesh. This is for pollution abatement of Ganga river under the National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG). The project has been secured with joint venture (JV) partner Pulkit projects.

The second order secured by the company worth Rs 34.50 crore is for planning, designing, engineering, procurement, construction, testing and commissioning of 10 MLD common effluent treatment plant (CETP) and 30 MLD main pumping station based on tertiary treatment for the industrial area of Bahadurgarh.
